HOPE IN ACTION-SUMMER SERMON SERIES continues through July 31. Christian hope is not passive. Hope is a verb, and we believe God has already begun his work of transforming the world. Hope is living into the future renewal of all things by God. In this series, we focus on how we can put our deep rooted HOPE in Jesus into action in our daily lives. Today, Tod Brown will wrap up this sermon series for us.

BEGINNING AUGUST 7, we will return to our annual sermon series, *The Word of the Lord*. The sermon texts will come from the Revised Common Lectionary, a three year cycle of scriptures that follows the Christian liturgical year from Advent to Lent, to Easter and beyond. Join us as we submit ourselves to the authority of God in every corner of scripture.

WHY WAS JESUS CRUCIFIED? Most Christians would (rightly) say “to save us from sin” or “to show us God’s love.” But what if there are other, equally important answers we have left mostly unexplored? At 9:30 a.m. on August 14 and 21, Brett Vanderzee will lead us through a two-part Bible class called *Gazing at Golgotha: Interpreting the Cross of Christ*. Through Scripture, art, poetry, and conversation, we hope to see more of what God has done in the crucified Christ, and in turn, more of what God is doing in us.
